A WORD TO STUDENTS

You forfeit your chance for life at its fullest when you withhold your best efforts in learning. When you give the minimum to learning, you receive only the minimum in return. Despite your parent's best examples and the teacher's unique efforts, eventually it is your work that determines how much and how well you learn. When you work to your full capacity, you can attain the knowledge and skill to create your future and control your destiny. If you do not, you will have your future thrust upon you by others. You must take hold of your life, apply your gifts and talents and work with dedication and self-discipline. You should have high expectations of yourself and convert every challenge into an opportunity.

You have to reach out and reach high in order to reach beyond.

SCHOOL POLICIES

- Self- discipline is the forte of the school.
- The school begins at 8:50 a.m. for the students. All students are expected to reach school before the bell rings. After 8:50 a.m. the school gates will be closed.
- Students should maintain cleanliness and hygiene within the school campus. Littering is prohibited.
- Students should observe polite civil behaviour. Ragging, screaming or use of unparliamentary language is forbidden.
- SGIPS constitutes a family of students from various communities, religious and linguistic groups. The medium of instruction and communication is English in the school campus.
- The school is not responsible for any loss of student's belongings in the premises.
- Under no pretext should a student miss any teaching/games or an activity period.
- Changing classrooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner. Students are expected to move quietly, in a single file without causing any disturbance to other classes.
- Students should remain in the classroom during break time.
- Students should not leave the premises during the school working hours.
- Students are not allowed to roam outside the school campus in their school uniforms, after school hours.
- Students have to carry his or her snack and lunch box in the morning, the same should not be delivered in the afternoon by parents, as it disturbs the school discipline.

CODE OF CONDUCT

We expect our students to maintain high standards of personal conduct. This includes personal honesty, discipline, integrity, humility, ethics and values. Students are accountable to the school authorities for their conduct in the school premises, for their general behaviour outside, in the school transport and at all school approved events or activities. Any objectionable conduct on the part of the students will lead to commensurate consequences, at the discretion of the Principal, whose decision on such matters is final.

The following undesirable behaviour/repeated indiscipline will lead to serious consequences:

- Irregular attendance.
- Bullying, gossiping, playing pranks or using any form of physical/emotional violence against a fellow student.
- Using unfair means during a test/examination.
- **Damaging school furniture, fixtures/building or belongings.**
- Scribbling or writing anything on the school uniform.
- Graffiti on the walls/school furniture/library books.
- Obscenity in use of words or acts and indulging in uncivilized behaviour.
- Insubordination to any member of the staff inside or outside the school.
- Indulging in any misbehaviour/misdeed directly or online this could be derogatory for any person or the institution.

Infrastructure

Science Laboratory: The school has a well-equipped and well-stocked science laboratory where specimens, models, picture-charts and educational CDs are used as effective tools to teach science. It is fully equipped to meet the curriculum requirements for practicals in Physics, Chemistry and Biology which includes demonstration and experimentation.

Computer Centre: The school has state-of-the-art computer labs with over 60 systems. A dedicated broadband Internet Connection in the Lab provides Internet Access to source websites for educational materials. All academic and administrative work is facilitated by the computer centre.

Math Lab: A well- equipped Math Lab provides students with the opportunity to have fun with numbers. It creates a challenging atmosphere for students to put their mathematical abilities to test and enhances their analytical reasoning and lateral thinking through various games and activities.

Media Centre: The library is the main resource for the students and the faculty. It has a special reference section and a reading room. CDs and video films are other note-worthy assets.

Health and Physical Activity: An excellent facility of sports at SGIPS caters to student's health and physical growth. The following sports facilities are provided in our school:

- a. Athletics
- b. Swimming
- c. Basketball
- d. Cricket
- e. Football
- f. Martial Arts
- g. Yoga.

Audio-Visual Room: The audio-visual room is extensively used by the faculty and the students to make presentations. A research-oriented approach is encouraged and frequent analysis of projects helps students orient themselves with the rapidly changing requirements of the world outside.

Guidance and Counselling: Qualified and experienced teachers act as counsellors and provide assistance for children with respect to learning, emotional and behavioural differences/difficulties observed in school. The children are referred to the counsellors by the class teachers and a preliminary assessment of the situation is made. Help is offered in terms of counselling and guiding students and parents. The counsellors also suggest suitable interventional remedies to handle difficulties. The capability and the outreach of the counsellors in the school are limited to an initial assessment of the issue.

Health care centre : The school has a Health Care Centre to take care of exigencies. However, students who suffer from any specific ailment should carry their medicine with them and inform the class teacher about it. We prefer to have your family doctor's name and telephone numbers to contact them in case of any emergency.

Doctor's Advice

- Do not send children to school when they are sick for attending classes or appearing for assessments to avoid spreading of microbial infections.
- All students returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease must produce a Fitness Certificate issued by a doctor permitting him/her to do so.
- Students suffering from any of the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before resuming classes.

Chicken pox : Till the blisters have completely dried and the scabs have fallen off

Measles : For 4 days after disappearance of rash

Mumps : For 9 days after onset of swelling

Whooping cough : For 7 days after effective antibiotic therapy

Jaundice : Till full recovery duly certified by the physician treating the patient

Flu (symptoms) : Till cough, cold, fever subsides completely – as guided by the physician.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Parents are requested to:

- Closely monitor your ward's progress by checking the school diary every day and paying attention to your punctuality, discipline and submission of school assignments.
- Make use of the space provided in the diary for any communication with the teachers.
- Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
- **Inform the school, if there is any change in address, telephone numbers and bus route.**
- Ensure that your ward does not bring expensive items, electronic items, cell phones and a large sum of money to school. The school bag should be randomly checked to ensure the same.
- Restrict celebration of birthdays of your ward in school. Elaborate arrangements like cutting of cake and partying in the school are not permitted. **“No coloured dress to be worn to school on such occasions. For Grade 6 to 10 they are expected to come only in school uniform.”** Return gifts are also not permitted.
- Explain to the child the need to look after his/her belongings. The school does not accept responsibility for any item lost in school. All articles belonging to the child should have identification details.
- Ensure that your ward is in proper school uniform. No fancy jewellery like danglers, trinkets, studs, rings etc. should be worn by girls/boys.
- Support and co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing discipline by making sure that their children attend school regularly, do the assignments, devote sufficient time to reading and revising their lessons at home and take interest in all the activities of the school.
- Availing of half a day leave is restricted to emergencies. In case of an emergency, written permission must be taken from the Principal/Vice Principal. In case a child leaves the school early, it is mandatory to inform the bus in – charge about the same, if the child avails the school transport facility.
- Ensure that during your ward's absence from school, work done in the class is made up at home.
- Girl child will not be sent alone permission letter to be given incase parents are unavailable to pick child during school hours.

- Provide a supportive value – based environment to your ward at home , using discretion and parental judgment. Keep track of your ward's mental health and emotional needs.
- Monitor the websites being visited by your ward and limit television viewing to appropriate programmes.
- Avoid private tuitions for your ward. The Principal, when it is found necessary, may advise parents to provide remedial measures for students who need personal coaching.
- Return the duly signed answer scripts of assessments to the school class teacher
- Sign in blue or black ink in all reports, notices and class work/ books of their ward when required to do so.
- Discourage your ward to take leave before the commencement of examinations, as these days are important as far as preparation is concerned.
- Avoid any kind of criticism of the child's teacher or the school in his/her presence as children may lose respect for their teachers and consequently fail to learn from them.
- Be formally dressed in the school premises.

Note: Cell phones are strictly not permitted within the school premises. (Statutory provision). However, for the security and safety of your ward, in case carrying of cell phone is considered a necessity, then a written request giving reason for the same should be forwarded to the school. In case of favourable consideration, the student will be required to deposit the mobile with the office staff. Students are permitted to use the office telephone to contact parents in times of emergency.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Fee has to be paid in two installments.

- Parents have the option to deposit fees for the whole year in advance.
- **Fees once paid will not be refunded.**
- **TC application request from the parent on or before 4th January, 2027.**

ATTENDANCE & REGULARITY

All students must be present on the re-opening day and closing day of each term. The names of the students who are absent on these days will be struck off from the rolls and the parents will have to seek re-admission for their children, if they want them to continue in the school.

The Class Teacher & Principal must be informed in writing when the student returns to school after being absent even for a single day. The parent must state the reason for her/his absence in the absence record of the school diary. **SUCH STUDENTS WHO ARE ABSENT FOR MORE THAN TEN DAYS WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN INTIMATION WILL HAVE THEIR NAMES STRUCK OFF THE ROLLS AND MAY NOT BE RE-ADMITTED.**

Students who are ill on the day of assessments are advised to come to school only if they can stay for the entire duration of the morning or afternoon session. Once the students are in school they are required to attend the full day school. Students are not permitted to arrive or leave in between the school hours. In case of any emergency, parents are required to call up the school and inform the absence of their ward and follow it up with a written leave letter.

ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

Applications for admission are accepted as and when notified in the school website. **PARENTS WISHING TO WITHDRAW THEIR CHILDREN AT THE END OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR MUST INFORM THE PRINCIPAL IN WRITING BEFORE THE END OF DECEMBER.** TC will not be issued, until all the dues are fully paid and all library books returned.

UNIFORM

- All students must be neatly dressed in full school uniform when they are in the school premises.
- Students are required to wear black shoes and white socks from Monday to Friday.
- Boys should wear vests and girls should wear slips and cycling shorts.
- School Uniforms & all items to be labelled.

Boys are not permitted to:

- Have long side burns, long hair, streaked hair and fancy hair styles.
- Wear bands/bracelets/chains/earrings
- Grow their beard, moustache

Girls are not permitted to:

- Have streaked hair, fancy hair styles, leave shoulder length or long hair untied.
- Wear eye makeup and more than one ear piercing.
- Wear gold/diamond earrings, bangles and chains, colourful and fancy jewellery, long earrings.
- Adorn their hair with flowers or colourful clips, paint their nails or apply mehendi.

Kindly note the days of wearing sports uniform :

Grades 1 & 2 - Tuesdays and Wednesdays

Grades 3 to 10 - Tuesdays and Thursdays (Depends on time table-Yoga & MPE Days)

USE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

- Students are permitted to use the computers at school for any purpose pertaining to the requirements of the school syllabus as specified by the computer faculty or for any school activity only.
- Students are not allowed to send messages on the network, create or view objectionable visuals, change system settings or delete files.
- Students who engage in cyber bullying by posting email, blogs, video footage, images, photographs on social networking sites, chat rooms, youtube, sms, mms which are:
 - Violent, aggressive or threatening
 - Dis-tasteful or obscene
 - Malicious rumours or gossip, classified as teasing or taunting
 - Verbally attacking, embarrassing or maligning, causing mental trauma or psychological damage by destroying the reputation of staff or students
 - Tarnishing the image of the school shall invite severe disciplinary action and are liable to be suspended from class or expelled from school.

USES OF ELECTRONIC GADGETS

Students are not permitted to carry mobile phones, iPods, I stations, PSPs, cameras or any other electronic gadgets to school. If they do so, it will be confiscated.

LUNCH AND SNACK BREAKS

- Students should bring lunch baskets with necessary cutlery, water and napkin to maintain personal hygiene.
- Parents, drivers or housekeepers are not allowed into the school premises to hand over lunch boxes during the break time.
- Parents are advised to send enough food for their wards, since children are not permitted to leave the campus at anytime during the hours of the school.
- No junk food to be sent.

PARKING

Students are advised to alight from their vehicles 10-15metres away from the school gate. Parents and drivers who park in front of the school gate while letting their children alight, cause congestion and confusion at the gate. Adequate place should be allowed in front of the school gate for comfortable movement of children.

WORKING DAYS AND VACATIONS

The kindergarten and Classes I-II maintain five – day week schedule unless required to make up for loss of academic hours due to unforeseen circumstances.

Parents are requested to refer to the school diary before planning a vacation and booking tickets.

- Classes III-X will work on 1st and 4th Saturday of every month.
- Saturdays are holidays for students of KG - Grade II
- 2nd & 3rd Saturdays are holidays . Dussehra, Diwali and Christmas vacations are mentioned in the calendar. Refer holiday list for festival holidays.
- Office working hours : 8.30 am to 5.00 pm

HOUSE SYSTEM

The school has a system to foster 'Esprit de corp's and work in a spirit of co-operation and healthy competition. There are four houses in the school. Every student on admission is placed in one of these Ruby-Red, Emerald-Green, Topaz-Yellow, and Sapphire-Blue. House meetings are held to organize and put into action various inter house events.

SCHEME OF EVALUATION

Evaluation of learning is a comprehensive process as it focuses on the daily, consistent progress made by the child. This procedure is based on the child's daily interaction in the class, his/her levels of general awareness, the quality of work produced by him/her and internalization of the concepts taught. The approach is not purely academic, but attaches equal importance to participate in co-curricular activities.

Scholastic areas

- There are two terms in an academic year.
- Assessments are carried out on the basis of the syllabus. A report is given at the end of each term.
- Evaluation assesses the concepts gained by the child and the areas that need to be further strengthened.
- Assessment is indicated in grades only.
- Scholastic areas have a five or nine point grading scale.

Co-Scholastic areas

- Co-Scholastic areas include personal and social qualities, regularity, punctuality, self discipline, personal hygiene, team spirit, civic sense, attitude of the student towards teachers/fellow students and school activities like Physical Education, Music, Dance and Art.
- A report of the assessment of Co-Scholastic areas including General Knowledge is given at the end of each term. Assessment is indicated in grades.
- Co-Scholastic areas have the following three point or five point grading scales.
